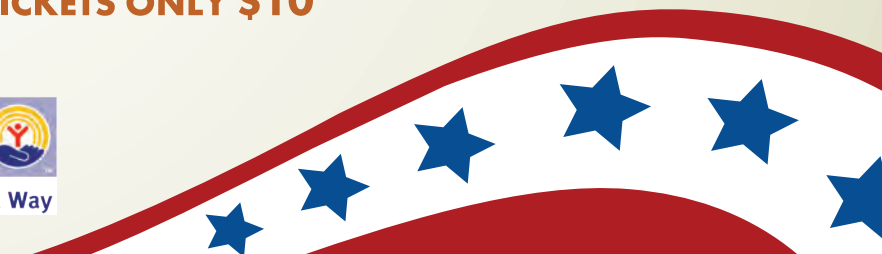

The sporting Clay Tournament will consist of 4-person teams. There will be 100 shots per person and shooting from multiple stations throughout the course. There will also be an awards ceremony with lunch following the shooting, sometime after 12 Noon, exact time depending on number of participants.

IMPORTANT DETAILS FOR PARTICIPANTS: Shooters responsible for their own eye/ear protection, gun, and shells (no magnums, shells are limited to 7 1/2's, 8's and 9's). Shells, shooting glasses, and ear plugs are available for purchase in the club house if you forget to bring your own. Alcohol only allowed during lunch. No unsupervised minors will be allowed to shoot. Event will happen rain or shine. Volunteers from the gun club will be shuttling shooters; please do not bring your own cart. **Participants must attend safety briefing & sign waivers during the morning registration, no matter skill level. If you miss the safety briefing in the morning you will not be allowed to participate in the clay shoot. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
