Why do we need Chaplaincy?

- •60% of people today have trouble focusing on their jobs b/c of personal problems
- •90% of absenteeism is due to personal or family problems
- •87% of people say that they would work harder for a company that cares about them and willing to help
- •65% of hours awake are spent in our work environment, in other words we are w/ our co-workers more than our family
- •86% of people say they believe in God but 70% have no religious affiliation
