# REGION 8 LOCAL VETERANS COMMITTEE REPORT JULY 2025

During this quarter, there were three local Veterans Committees that had a new Chair appointed. With both the Region 8 Standing Committee Conference and The National Veterans Conference in Black Lake taking place next quarter, the newly appointed Chairs are looking forward to getting some ideas on how to move forward with their Committees. Several Committees were able to take advantage of the financial assistance offered through the availability of the Region 8 scholarships.

### Local 129 (Grand Prairie, TX)

\* A new Chair has been appointed to the Local 129 Veterans Committee. I am waiting for their contact information.

## Local 276 (Grand Prairie, TX)

- \* The Veterans Committee sponsored a CPR training class at the Union Hall. Everyone who successfully completed the requirements received a certification.
- \* Due to unforeseen circumstances, the Military Veterans Appreciation Program that was planned for May has been rescheduled. They are currently shooting for August.
- \* In conjunction with the GM Veterans Group, the Veterans Committee participated in the Wounded Warrior Run. They also worked together to honor Veterans and their families by placing flags at the Dallas National Cemetery for Memorial Day. They returned to remove the flags 31 May.
- \* The Veterans Committee continues to encourage its members to be active in the community and to come forward with new ideas.

### Local 862 (Louisville, KY)

- \* One of our Veterans Committee members was selected to participate in an Honor Flight Bluegrass. He chose a fellow committee member as his chaperone.
- \* The Committee sponsored a fuel stop for the Run For The Wall group as they passed through Waddy, KY.
- \* The Local 862 Color Guard presented the Colors at the opening ceremony for the Independent Parts Suppliers Conference that was held in Louisville, KY.
- \* The Committee sent nine Veterans to the 2025 UAW-Ford Veterans Conference in Detroit, MI.
- \* The VA held a public Town Hall at the Local 862 Union Hall.

## Local 1853 (Springhill, TN)

- \* The Veterans Committee donated \$500 in gift cards to help five families in need in Marshall County for Easter. They also donated another \$500 to families in Robertson County.
- \* The Committee purchased and donated \$200 worth of socks and under garments to the Marshall County Veterans Center. They were able to make another donation of \$100 worth of under garments the following month, as well.

- \* The Local lost one of their brothers, SGM James C. Martin, to lung cancer. It was a loss that was felt in all the Veteran Committees throughout Region 8. Jimmy will forever be remembered for his sharp wit and uncanny ability to speak his mind, even if you didn't want to hear it. He was the cornerstone of Local 1853's Veterans Committee. He attended 27 of the last 30 National Veteran Conferences in Black Lake. He made sure he met as many new people as he could at every Conference. He will be loved and missed by so many. ## Local 2069 (Dublin, VA)

- \* A new Chair for the Veterans Committee was appointed.

- \* The Committee was able to get approval to have a POW/MIA table permanently displayed at the Local Union Hall. Members of the Disabled American Veterans came in to perform the Remembrance Ceremony.
